They came to visit Tanzania from Congo and Kenya. We also led one Hearing young man to Christ. It's always joyous to see people joining Christ's sheep-fold. Praise the Lord! Hallelujah! We're teaching some of the converters in the church to be baptized.

Praying toward the mark of High Calling of God with the Land

Although, we don't have money but we believe that all things are possible with God. Through faith, we were determined to occupy 26 acre of land in Dodoma, the capital state

of Tanzania. The land has been surveyed and granted to us by the Capital



Development Authority, a designed government agency that handles for Master Plan and issues the offer of land. The original title is being processed in the name of Bethel Baptist Deaf Church. We have made some payment for paper work and survey fees. We have also paid \$6,000 for the purchase toward the land. We further agreed with the seller that the church would pay little by little over time whenever funds are available we pay off the full price of



\$60,000. The seller has lowered the cost. Meanwhile, the premises are now ready for the mission project to take off. We're praying and looking for source of funding. We occupied this land by trusting that God will provide us finance for this project initiative. The land value goes up daily in Tanzania. We have a vision in which we would like to

establish a main mission center where we can have a massive mission program such as Christian school, Bible College to train leaders to serve Deaf in Africa, mission hospital, and other mission related projects. All of these, we shall commence with a small phase leading up to bigger phase. Our church will organize a fundraising campaign in Tanzania. We heartedly invite Christians like you to invest in our mission program for Christ's sake. Would you please lift us in your prayer and consider supporting this mark of high calling of God.





The land is located in an attractive area which is close to the Chamber of Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania (look at the picture from left), University of Dodoma (look at the picture from the right), and paved main highway from Dar es Salaam to the second largest city in Tanzania where Lake Victoria is located. It takes 5 miles to Dodoma city center.



Sustainability:

As our ministry is pressing toward the mark of the land that shall be a home of its ministries, sustainability project is recommended in raining a massive mission program because it enables mission field to support itself financially instead of being endless dependent on donor support. Twenty-six acre land that we have occupied in Dodoma is large enough. We could use even 1-2 acre to set up a tangible investments which will lead to sustainability project for income for generations to come in order to support
