The preaching of the Word has been a significant task that changing the lives of the believers at Bethel Baptist Deaf Church where many of the newly converted believers had made a decision to be baptized as the second step of obedience to the Scripture. However, baptism service didn't take place due to lack of a baptistery pool in our church. There is neither a body of water such as an ocean nor lake nearby in



the town of Dodoma which we could use to baptize. So, we decided to raise some funds to build a baptistery wall. Praise the Lord that we were able to raise a small amount of money while some funds were donated from our friends and supporting churches. Thank you so much for your love gift for God's glory in our mission field. The construction project for baptistery wall is currently underway.

## **Outreach and Activities**

Our deaf church has been emphasizing and training the deaf regarding soul-winning. They are currently evangelizing others and bringing them to Christ. Through evangelism outreach, the people have been coming to church on Sundays. Some of them are hearing and parents of deaf

children. Last December, we celebrated the Annual Christmas Banquet. Each year, we celebrate Christmas festive with purpose to proclaim the nativity to the unsaved people who are invited to the banquet so that they may receive Jesus Christ. About 40 people attended the event. The nativity message touched the heart of the attendants where many made a decision to renew their lives for Christ.
