When they left the office, I told some staff and a director who is also one of our church folk that they are false missionaries and to be aware of them. We who know the true Gospel ought to work harder instead of allowing a false religion to outwork us.

Youth and Children Ministry

As Christmas approaches, we pray that the Lord will enable us to use the many opportunities we have to share His joy with the deaf people here in Tanzania. There is a potential for our mission to expand a program for youth and children ministries. Last November I distributed a number of letters to the parents asking them to allow their children to come to Church. Some parents have responded that they would like their children to worship God but don't have money to provide for their transportation fare as most of them are living in poverty. A few young people and children have approached me to inform of their desire to come to church but they were stuck at home due to lack of money for bus fare. Therefore, I am asking you to pray as we really need a van or minibus to help us reach the children for Christ, the bus would enable us to pick up children at the main bus stations and carry other ministry activities. Please help us for Christ's sake.

Education Shortage

It is unfortunate to many deaf children in Tanzania who have lacked an opportunity to be enrolled in school due to limited enrollment rate caused by the shortage of deaf schools in Tanzania. There were more than 100 deaf children who applied for enrollment at Buguruni School for the Deaf but only 20 out of 100 children were enrolled. Where will other children who have missed the opportunity go to obtain education? Many parents have cried for their children's education. Please pray for them and that God will open the door for our ministry to establish a Christian School for the Deaf in the future. This shall be another means of opening doors to the Gospel through educational program.



50th Independence Anniversary



On December 9, 2011 Tanzania marked 50th year of Independence from British since 1961. During the Golden Jubilee Independence Day; I went to the Uhuru Stadium where the celebration was being held, to search for deaf souls. The ceremony was scheduled to commence at 10:00 am, I and other believers got to the venue at 8:00 am hopefully to obtain seats; however, the stadium was already filled to capacity at 6:00 am! Our effort didn't succeed due to the massive crowd full of people which blocked spaces at the venue. Such an effort is not vain to God's eyes as we obeyed the great commandment to go.
