We have built Baptist Deaf churches in Tanzania through your dedicated support, this building is a Deaf Church in Ruvuma, a Southern Highland part of the United Republic of Tanzania. This church was planted in 2017 and it being led by Pastor Samwel Mahena who has recently been ordained as a pastor after 5 years of leadership training by me. You can see the Deaf having a fellowship outside the building. This building was also built through missions support.
