First baptism of the year

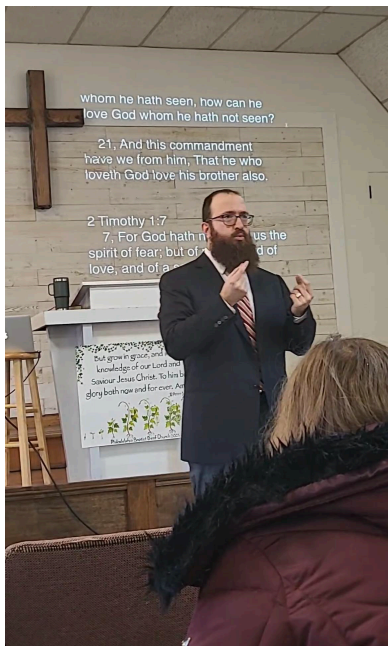
